HOURS

This is a part-time position. Two hours of teaching per week, one hour training, and .5 hour of prep, for a total of 3.5 paid hours per week. More hours for performances as needed and approved. If qualified, and more hours are desired, this position may be combined with other teaching positions at the school.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Responsibilities for this position include:

- Enthusiastically implement choral music instruction in a classical style.
- Prepare students for regular performances in school devotionals, as well as twice-yearly music concerts.
- Demonstrate a commitment to professional growth in classical, Christian education through attendance at weekly faculty meetings, yearly participation in the Belmont teacher conference, and self-paced study.
- Maintain a well-disciplined class of middle and high school students, while showing each student respect and dignity as a child of God.
- Receive feedback from administrators upon observation, and effectively implement suggestions for improvement.
- Wholeheartedly support the Belmont mission and motto, and adhere to Biblical, Christian teachings and conduct.
